



**VILLAGE OF HUGHENDEN
PROVINCE OF ALBERTA
BYLAW NO. 503-18**

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF HUGHENDEN, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, BEING ENACTED FOR THE PURPOSE TO “APPOINT AN ASSESSOR AS A DESIGNATED OFFICER”. THIS BYLAW SHALL BE KNOWN AS THE “ASSESSMENT BYLAW”

WHEREAS, Under and by virtue of the authority conferred upon it by the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, SECTION 284 and amendments thereto requires that an Assessor be appointed as a Designated Officer;

AND WHEREAS, Under and by virtue of the authority conferred upon it by the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, SECTION 210 and amendments thereto outlines the appointment of the Designated Officers;

NOW THEREFORE, The Council of the Village of Hughenden in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, does enact the following:

THAT, Larry James be appointed as the Designated Assessor of the Village.

THAT, the Designated Assessor, as a Designated Officer of the Village, carry out the duties of an Assessor as outlined under Part 9, 10, 11 and 12 of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000.

THAT, Bylaw No. 451/06 and any and all other bylaws pertaining to the establishment or appointment of the position of Designated Assessor or Designated Officer be hereby rescinded.

Within this Bylaw,
“Council” means the council of the Village.

“Village” means the Village of Hughenden.

“Assessor” means the assessor of the Village of Hughenden.

This Bylaw shall have force and take effect on the final reading thereof.

READ A SECOND TIME THIS 17th day of July, A.D. 2018.

READ A THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 17th day of July, A.D. 2018.
