

VILLAGE OF HUGHENDEN
LAND USE AMENDMENT BYLAW 525-23
PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF HUGHENDEN, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, BEING ENACTED FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING BYLAW 413 LAND USE BYLAW.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Hughenden deems it necessary to amend Land Use Bylaw 413 by changing the number of days from 14 to 21 in section 4.1(4).

NOW THEREFORE, The Council of the Village of Hughenden in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, does enact the following:

1. **THAT** Section 4.1 (4) of Land Use Bylaw 413 be replaced by the following:

4.1(4) to read "An appeal shall be made by serving a written notices of appeal to the Secretary of the Board, together with reasons and the development appeal fee as established by resolution of Council, within twenty-one (21) days after. "
2. **THAT** Land Use Bylaw 413 and amendments shall, in all other respects, remain the same.
3. **THAT** the above Land Use Amendment Bylaw 525-23 shall be in effect upon 3rd reading and signing.

This Bylaw shall have force and take effect on the final reading thereof.

READ A FIRST TIME THIS 17th day of October, A.D. 2023.

READ A SECOND TIME THIS 2nd day of November, A.D. 2023.

READ A THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 17th day of November, A.D. 2023.
